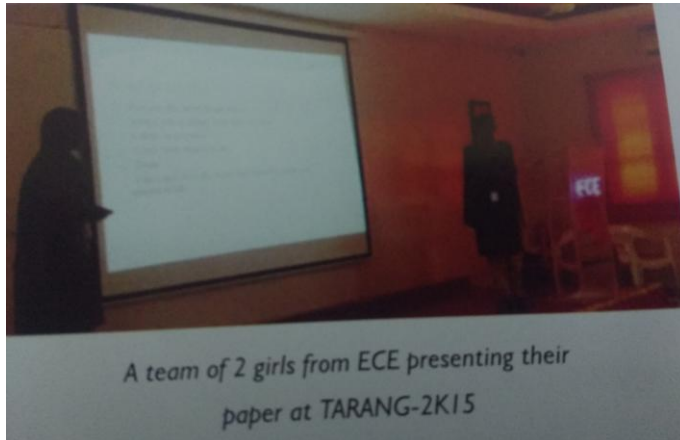


Events:**TARANG-2K15:**
