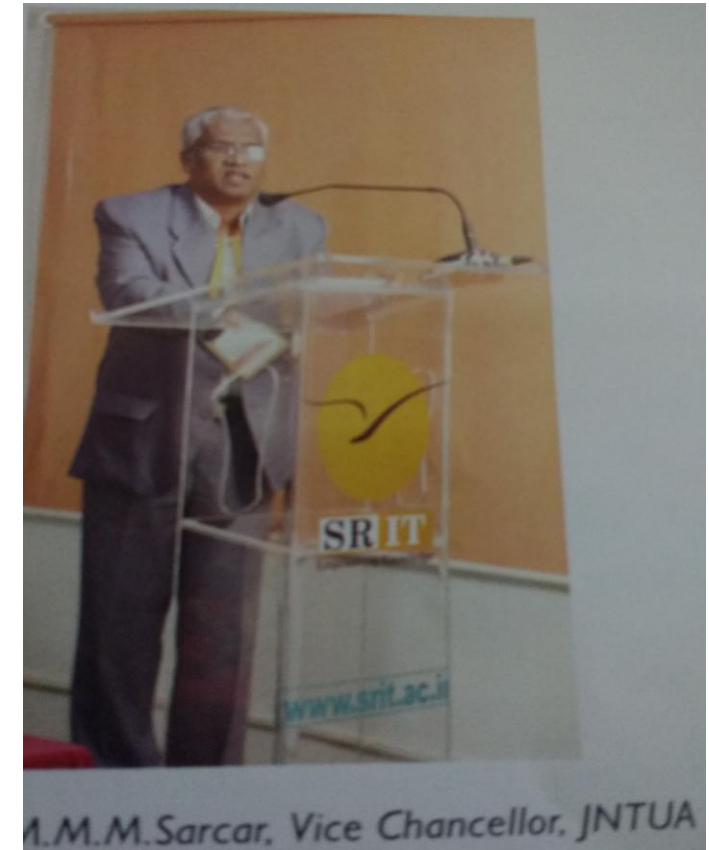


the papers that were presented at the conference will be published in the Lecture Notes in Electrical Engineering (LNEE) by Springer.

about the need and necessities of Cyber Security.

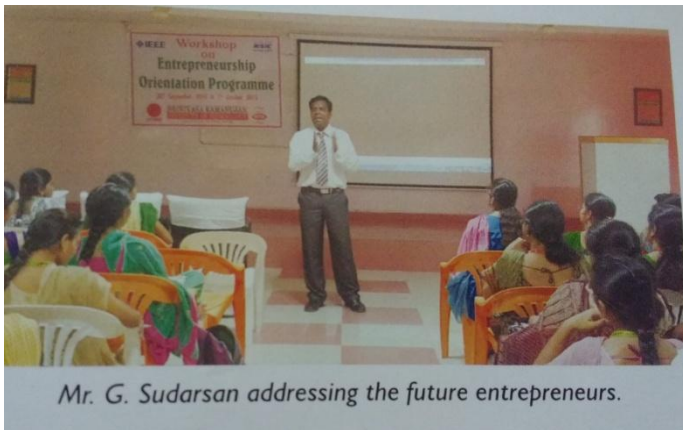
