Summary of Manoj Kumar's speech on Water Transportation

- ✓ In INDIA we having a long coastal region for exporting and importing the goods through water transportation, but we couldn't utilize this opportunity. We are depending on the road and rail transportation majorly. But some other countries like Singapore and Hong Kong, they depend on the water transportation. Though those countries are smaller than India but their economy growth is bigger than India.
- ✓ In India, only 6 to 7% transportation is on water, whereas in case of other countries it is 93 to 94%.
- ✓ Comparing the costs of transportation for a product; if the transportation cost of a product is 1Rrupee by road then it will take 80 paisa through rail, whereas, the cost will be only 38

- to 40 paisa on water. We can utilize this opportunity and increase our economy growth.
- ✓ Finally, we should encourage the water transportation, increase our Indian economy growth and decrease the environment pollution and save the nature.

✓ In the First Round, she spoke on "Incredible India" and on "Being Human" in semifinal round. In her speech in semifinals she put emphasis on human relations.
